



RSWM to turn into a USD 1 billion enterprise by 2016

Bhilwara, September 8, 2011: Rajasthan Spinning & Weaving Mills Ltd. (now known as RSWM Ltd.), one of country's oldest textiles company on Thursday announced that it aims to turn into a USD 1 billion conglomerate by 2016. Ahead of its Golden Jubilee Celebrations, the company announced it is investing Rs 1,500 cr in capacity expansion.

We enjoy a 35% share of the polyester yarn segment and a dominant position in yarn exports including special high-value yarns. We also expect to add sophisticated spinning equipment that will take our spindle capacity to 700,000, retaining our position as India's second-largest spinning company. We shall enhance our denim installed capacity from 14 million meters per annum to about 18 million meters and expect to commission a spinning facility dedicated to denim manufacture strengthening our integration and profitability. We believe that this blueprint will graduate the company into a truly global enterprise over the foreseeable future."

RSWM Ltd. is among the leading textiles company of Rajasthan and country and has created many milestones in its five decades' journey. On its Golden Jubilee Shri JC Laddha, Executive Director, informed that in last one year it has commercialised 11 innovative products including yarn from special materials like bamboo and soya.
