CORPORATE OVERVIEW

HEG: 9 month review

Despite the global meltdown which has hit infrastructure industries like steel manufacturing which directly affects HEG, the company, by judiciously trimming back capex on expansion plans has reported net sales of Rs. 775.35 crore, higher by 8.46% from Rs. 714.84 crore on the back of stabilized capacities and increase in realizations in the graphite segment. Contribution from graphite segment expanded by 18.97% to Rs. 772.55 crore. Export revenues increased by 14.09% to Rs. 619.08 crore. The Company's power segment, which includes its 30 MW thermal power plant and 13.5 MW hydel plant (at Tawa) reported revenues at Rs. 72.38 crore.

HEG gets ISO 9001:2008 Ahead of Others

HEG (Graphite Division) has earned the distinction of becoming the first organization in the Central Zone to achieve the ISO 9001:2008 certificate. Though the Quality Management Systems were released by ISO Sat Geneva, on 15th November, the Indian nodal agency for implementing ISO in India, BIS, has still not published the revised standards. However, with the pro-active approach prevailing at HEG, we decided to obtain and implement the revised standards in the shortest possible time and offered our systems for an audit on 31st December. After the audit, the Bureau Veritas auditors appreciated the commitment of the top management and were highly satisfied with the results of the audit.

Mr. R. C. Surana (ED & CEO), Mr. Jacob Mani (COO), Mr. K. K. Puri (MR) and other senior executives have expressed their appreciation of this achievement and offered their best wishes to all ISO leaders.

ISO Certification renewal completed at RSWM, Mandpam

RSWM Ltd. Mandpam Unit has successfully completed the ISO 9001:2000 audit by BIS. This was renewal step in the process of being awarded the ISO 9001:2000 certification for its business processes. External auditors visited the Mandpam unit on 17th & 18th November, 2008 to conduct a comprehensive audit of business processes and quality systems, including development processes, materials documentation practices, and measurement systems. To RSWM's customers, successful completion of the certification process reflects the company's on-going commitment to product and service quality, and to continuous improvement.

ISO 9001:2000 renewal audit for Bhilspin

The renewal audit for ISO 9001:2000 certificate was held on January 13-15. A team of three auditors from Bureau of Indian Standards, New Delhi confirmed the successful completion of the audit of Non-conformity and recommended the renewal of the ISO 9001:2000 certification.

ADHPL-PROJECT UPDATE

• Completion of face 7 and face 8 of Allain HRT

The major achievement for the quarter is the breakthrough of the 525-meter-long face 7 and face 8 of Allain Head Race Tunnel. This breakthrough has been achieved under very difficult geological conditions.

• Completion of Allain Barrage

With tireless efforts put in by engineers and workers at an altitude of 2750 meters, major intake structures of the Barrage on Allain river have been completed. All senior engineers and Mr. Ashok Joshi, Project in-charge, thanked the engineers and workers for their splendid contribution and congratulated them on this occasion.



• Power House, ADHPL

In the Power house box-up work for Unit#1 has been completed during this quarter including filling of oil in all the bearings. Box up work of Unit # 2 already stands completed, thus the major works of both the machines have been completed. Testing of Air Compressors and 5 No Cooling Water Pump motors (3x90 KW and 2x18.5 KW) on no load has been successfully completed. Commissioning of LT panels for various auxiliaries inside power house has also been completed.



• 220 KV switchyard

In 220 KV surface Switchyard, all tower structures and gantries have been erected and stringing work completed.

CSR Initiatives

Clean Energy at Group's Power Companies

Malana Power Company Ltd.

The Malana Hydro Electric Power Project, commissioned in July, 2001 has already generated 346.81 MU of clean energy as of December 2008. As part of the constant endeavor, to make Malana a world-class power house, the installation of Computerized Maintenance Management System has also been planned. This will document all maintenance failures through Reliability Centered Maintenance.

In keeping with the sustainable and ecologically friendly nature of the project, it also carries out other CSR activities on a regular basis. At the moment, the following initiatives are operational in and around the project area:

- Acupressure Health Center runs by two qualified acupressure therapists.
- Free medical Aid provided to Chowki and Jari villagers.
- Ambulance services to ferry patients in case of emergency to Community Health Center-Jari and to Zonal Hospital-Kullu
- CBSE-affiliated School at Project Campus to provide education to wards of employees and locals. The school is equipped with five computers.
- Three teachers at the Govt. Primary School at Chowki village.
- Financial help, construction material and household goods provided to villagers whose houses were gutted during a recent fire.
- An annual contribution of INR 0.45 million per year towards sponsorship of social, cultural and sports activities in local villages.
- Extensive plantation activities with 60,000 trees planted so far around the project area; 550 fruit trees; and a further 20,000 trees each proposed the current and next year.

AD Hydro Power Ltd.

Allain Duhangan Hydro Electric Project (192 MW) located near Prini village, Manali in Himachal Pradesh runs on the river project utilizing the inflow of two small tributaries, Allain and Duhangan, of river Beas. The project is designed to generate 800 MU in a 90% capacity annually. Committed to abide by the stringent environmental and social conditions agreed with the Ministry of Environment & Forests, Government of India, Himachal Pradesh State Environment Protection, Pollution Control Board and IFC, while proceeding with the construction of the project, the Company has taken various proactive measures to mitigate the impact of the project on the local population.

Till date the Company has spent approx. Rs. 40 crore for community development works, catchment area treatment and compensatory afforestation. Some of the highlights are:

- A grievance redressal System, which addresses issues, brought forward by local Panchayats of Prini, Jagatsukh and Aleo. More than one hundred twenty five such issues have been amicably resolved with the local residents.
- Operational dispensaries in Prini and Jagatsukh. ADHPL-appointed doctors treat 100-125 patients daily. Free medicines and ambulance services are also provided.
- Temple renovation at Prini, Shuru and Jagatsukh.
- Construction of a floor for Mahila Mandal at Prini Village and a two-storey Community Centre for Sethan Villagers.
- Construction of more than 40 toilets in the project area and project-affected villages.
- INR 48, 00, 000 deposited with the Government of Himachal Pradesh to provide drinking water to Jagatsukh, Aleo and Chhanala.
- Apart from the above ADHPL regularly contributes to the Kullu Dussehra Festival, Manali Winter Carnival, National Association for Blind, Aleo Baisakh Mela, Haripur Deshehra Mela and other cultural fixtures.
- During the construction period, employment has been provided to one member of each family which has sold land for the implementation of the project. As per its commitment to the state government, the project also maintains a high ratio of Himachalis on its rolls: out of the total employee strength 465, at present the project employs 390 (84%) Himachalis.
- As its contribution to the local economy, the project has offered all small to medium contracts on infrastructure works to locals. About 2800 contracts worth over Rs.100 crore have been awarded to contractors from Prini, Jagatsukh and Aleo villages.

Planned developmental activities in consultation with the affected communities of Prini, Jagatsukh, Aleo and Shuru are listed below:

1. Electrification works for local areas
2. Provision for School Building and subsidy
3. Health Management Plan – Health facilities
4. Provision for Police Station (Building & Recurring expenses) at Prini
5. Water supply schemes for villages
6. HIV/AIDS awareness programme and capacity building.
