





It's the stress, it's the worry. When you get out of your thinking mind, you go into this other place, where you focus on anysound you hear. The sound of the heating system, traffic outside or voices in the background. When you're through, you'll notice that your heart rate has slowed down, your breathing has slowed down, and your muscles are loosened.





Smart Foods For A Smarter Brain

A brain-healthy diet optimizes your capacity for keeping a healthy, sharp and active brain over a lifetime — while reducing the risk of developing age-related cognitive impairments and dementia. Over the years, various research indicates that the following foods may boost our grey cells in some form or the other-

1. Dark leafy greens (spinach, swiss chard, kale and all sort of greens) and cruciferous vegetables (broccoli, cauliflower, cabbage) are all full of vitamins, minerals, fibre and disease - fighting nutrients that are crucial for a healthy nervous system.

- 2. Berries (especially blackberries, blueberries, strawberries, raspberries but also dark cherries, goji berries, mulberries) are packed with antioxidants that help keep memory sharp as you age.
- 3. Extra virgin vegetable oils, especially olive oil and flaxseed oil. These are loaded with anti-ageing nutrients, such as omega-3s and vitamin E. Olive oil is also rich in monounsaturated fat, a kind of fat that is good for the heart. What is good for the heart is good for the brain.
- 4. Complex carbohydrates, such as wholegrains, legumes and sweet potatoes, are packed with brain-supportive nutrients from protein to B vitamins to a bounty of antioxidants and minerals.
- 5. Fatty fish (salmon, mackerel, bluefish, sardines, anchovies) contains a blend of nutrients that are perfect for the brain, including omega-3 fats (a brain-must), choline (a B vitamin needed to make memories), vitamins B6 and B12 (needed to support the nervous system), minerals such as iron and magnesium (needed for healthy blood and tissues) and a good amount of protein.


The Scotland of India

With picture sque hills and lush greenery all around, a trip to this coffee growing region is always memorable.

from Madikeri, the beautiful Abbey Falls are a popular tourist attraction in the hill resort of Coorg. Even during the summer there is plenty of water in these falls.

- > **Iruppu Falls:** These scenic waterfalls are situated at a distance of 48 kms from Virajpet on the way to Nagarhole. River Lakshmana-tirtha flows nearby. The people of Coorg believe that bathing in the Iruppu Falls will wash one's sins away.
- > The Omkareshwar temple: This temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva, it has a mix of Islamic and Gothic style architecture. On the top of the dome of the temple is a guilded ball, with a weather clock. It is unique for its architectural beauty which is a combination of Islamic and Gothic style of architecture.
- > The Raja's Seat: This is a beautiful viewpoint in Coorg. This hilltop offers stunning views of the surrounding forests and the view of the sunset. It is said that the kings of Kodagu came to this viewpoint to see the panoramic view of their kingdom and spent their evenings.
- > **Bhagamandala:** It is situated at the confluence of 3 rivers (the Cauvery, the Kanika and the Sujyothi). It is famous for temples and is known as the temple town of this region. The temple here, built in Kerala style, has smaller shrines dedicated to various gods.
- > Madikeri Fort: Situated in the middle of Madikeri, this historic fort which was built in the 19th century, contains a museum, a prison, a chapel and a temple.

How to reach Coorg

The nearest airports are Mangalore 136 km and Bengaluru 260 km

By Rail: The nearest Railway Station to Coorg is Mysore, which is at 114 km

Coorg is well connected by surface network with major cities like Mysore, Mangalore and Bengaluru (260 km)
